






# Xavier Covarrubias

oportunidade de ir para o gol em razão da ausência do, então, goleiro titular. Nesse jogo, defendeu pênalti, pegou faltas difíceis, além de outras boas defesas, e acabou sendo um dos destaques da partida.



No ano de 2022, foi bicampeão da RioCup, categoria Sub 9, e defesa menos vazada. Com a fama de goleiro artilheiro, já soma 42 gols na carreira.

Paralelamente aos jogos do Flamengo, atuou por outros times. Com destaque para equipe do Ascaer e Crias. Pelo primeiro, foi vice-campeão da Rio Futsal sub 7 e defesa menos vazada; campeão da Rio Futsal Sub 8 e defesa menos vazada; campeão da Comary Cup Sub 8; e campeão da Taça Donos da Bola e defesa menos vazada. Já pelo segundo, foi campeão Estadual e Brasileiro pela IberLeag e defesa menos vazada/melhor goleiro nas duas edições.

working family that enjoys playing sports. His sister Brianna is a great student athlete excelling in volleyball. His mothers secret to success is, "Lots of beans & rice."




