My short term goals are very simple. Improve

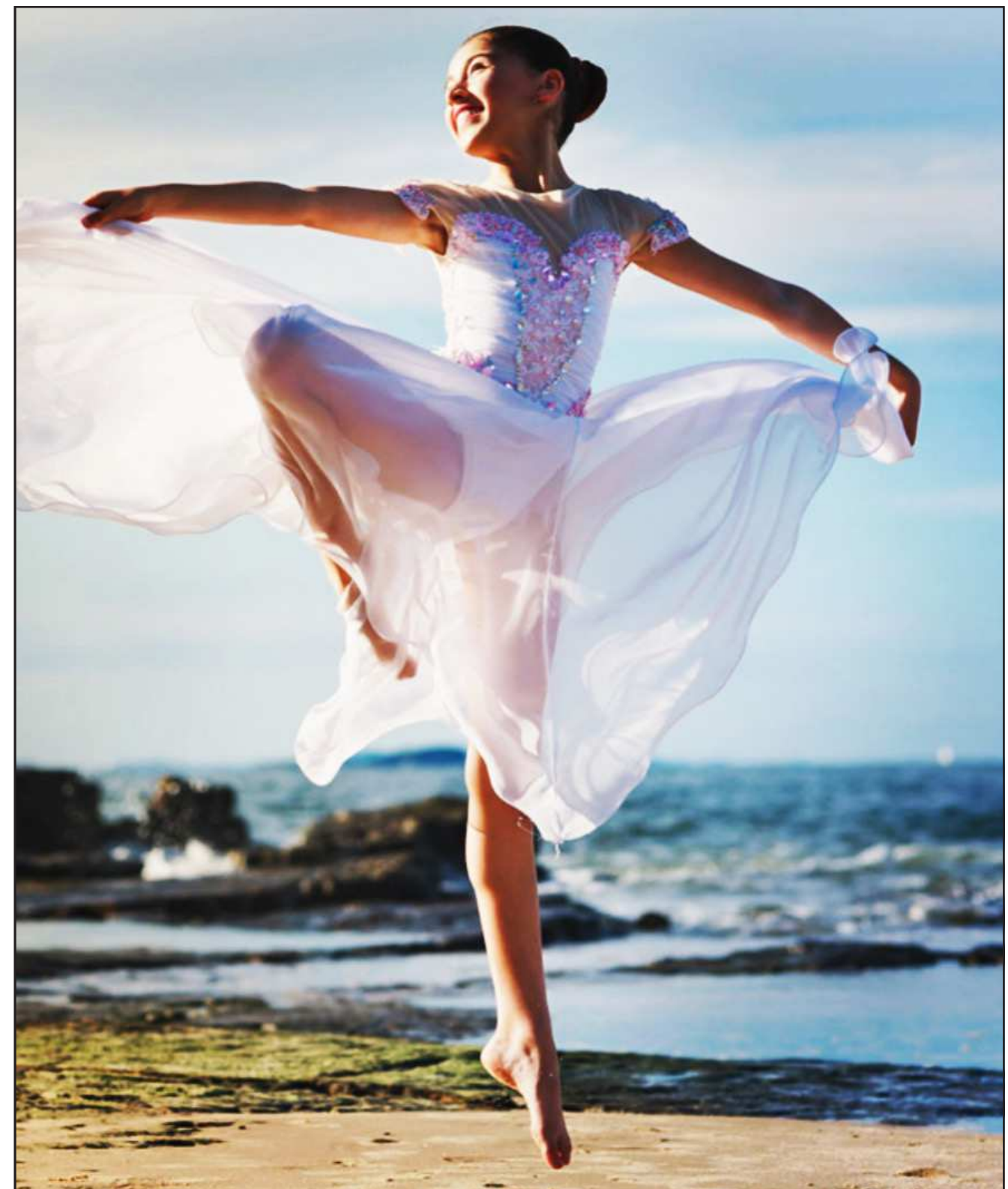
everyday. Be a better version of myself than yesterday and walk away from each performance knowing I gave it everything I have to give!

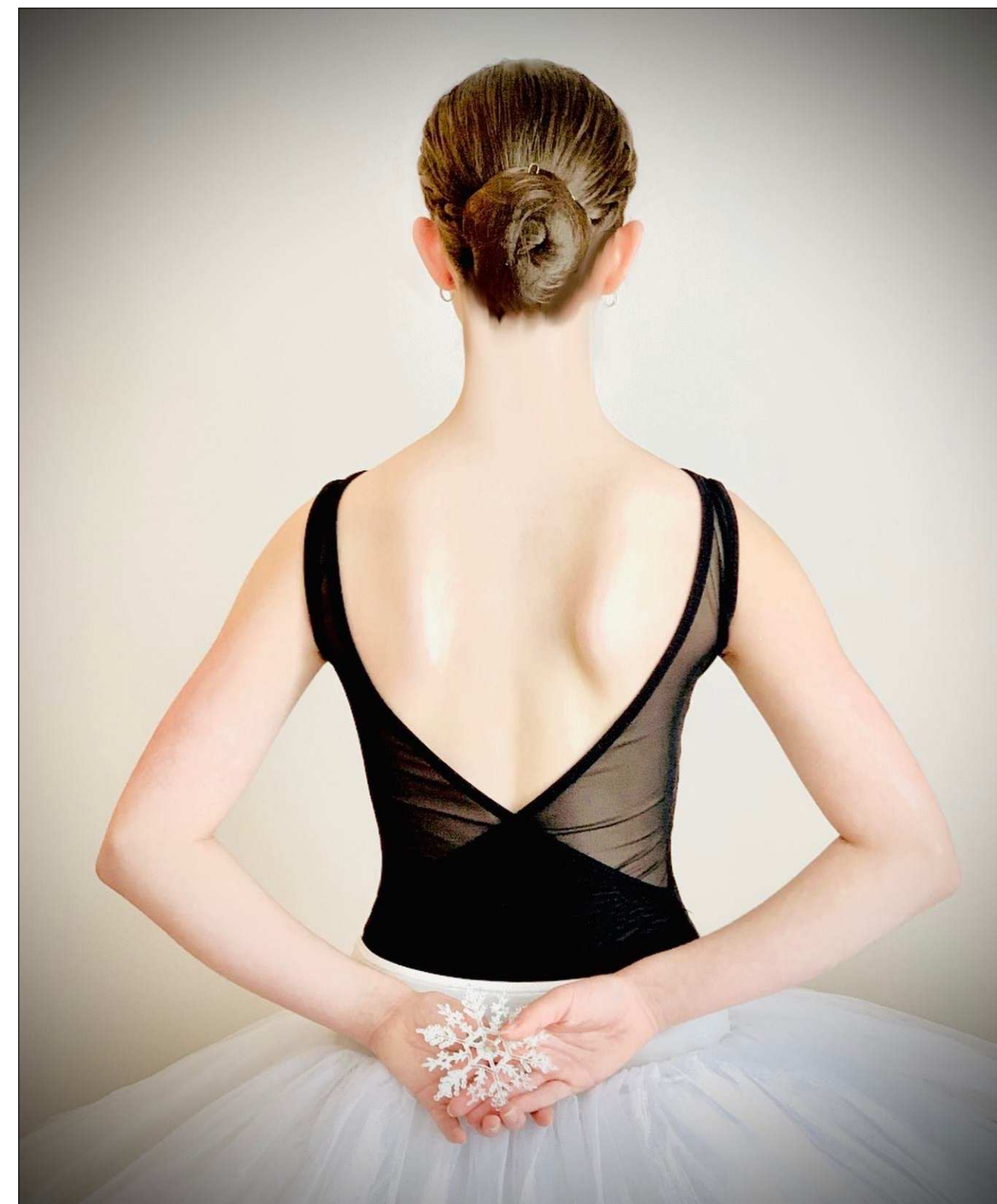

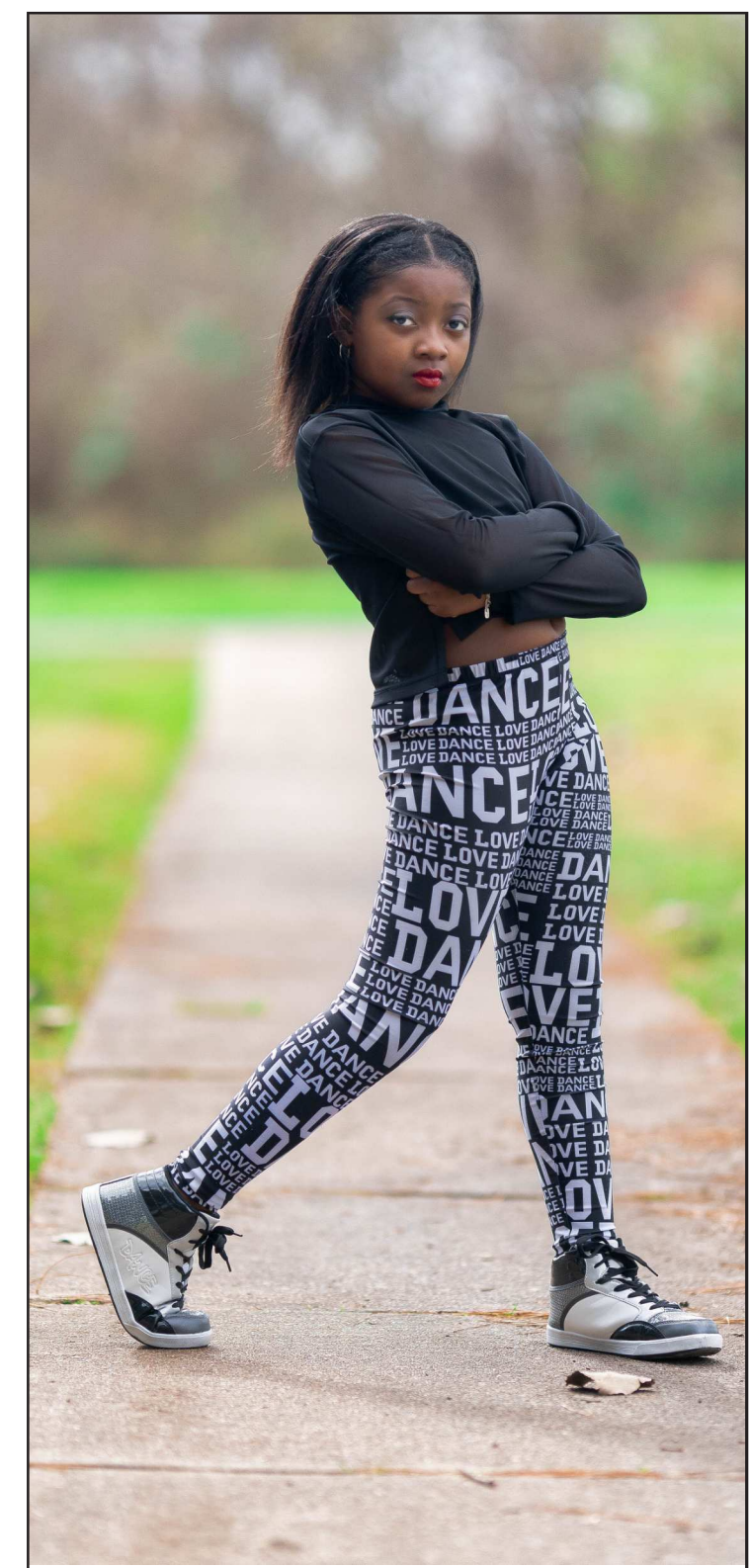


environment. Most importantly, she believes that it is important to dance where you are seen, heard, not overlooked, or put into a box.
