My dream is to have my own dance studio to pay it forward. I want to be able to share my passion for dance with others.

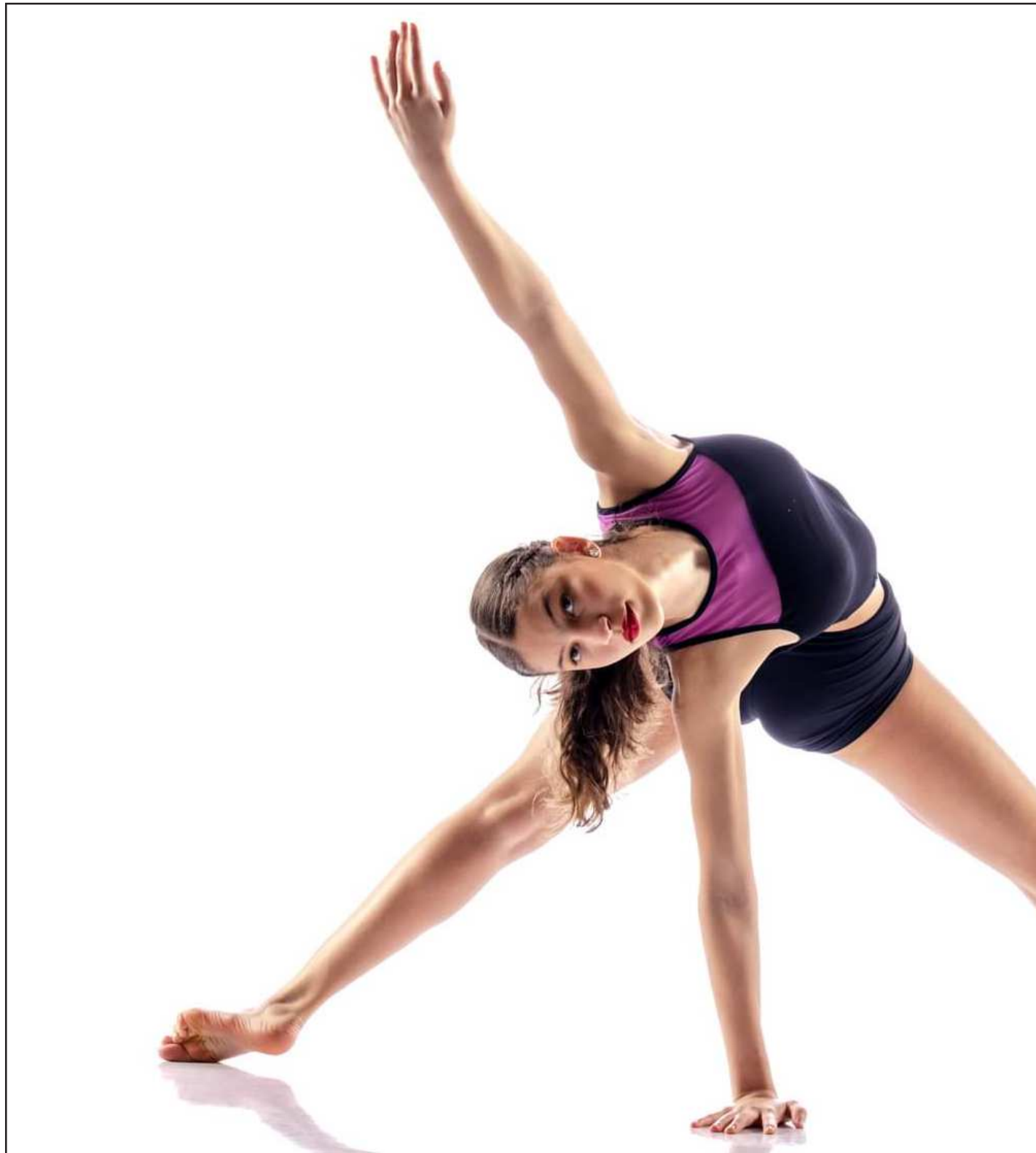

The challenge I currently face is whether to attend a 4yr college for dance or audition for a dance company. I am excited because either road will lead me to dance which has been my life long dream.

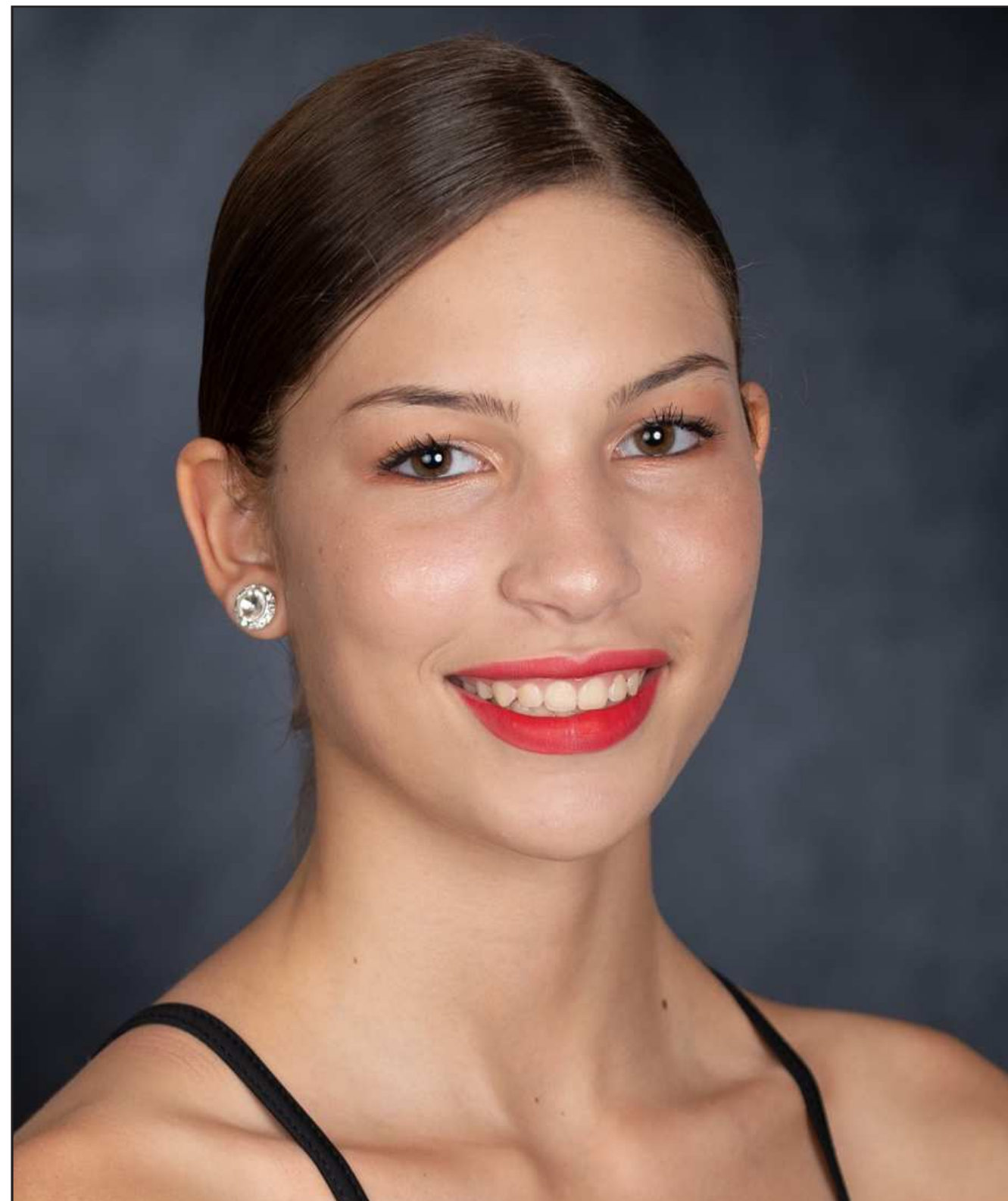

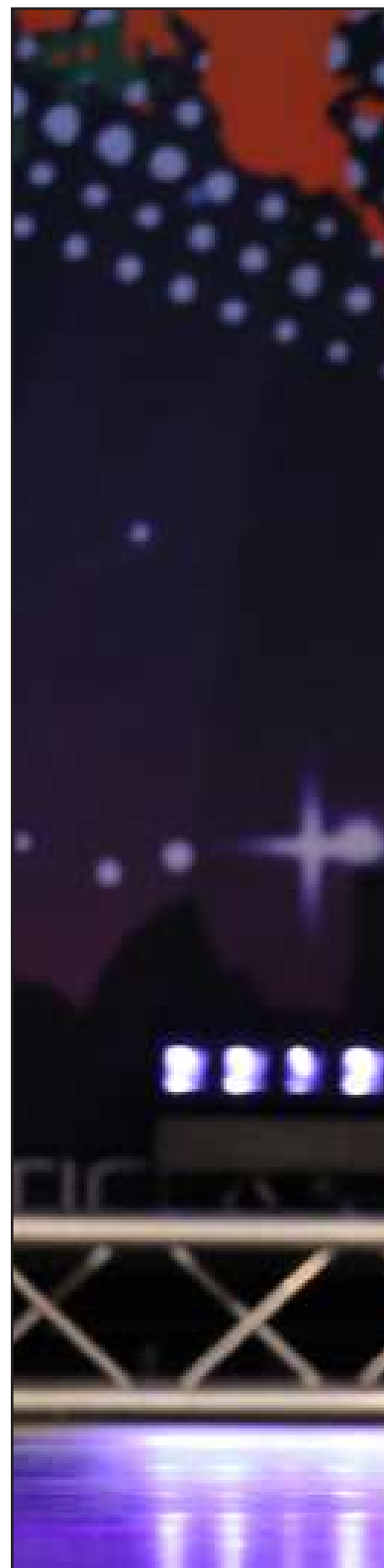
Hi my names Dakota Esmé Bolt,
