
Aityanna Andrade




My name is Alyssa Poppell. My dream is to be a famous gymnast one day. I struggle with my left arm because I've broke it twice and it's


I am so thankful for all of my coaches that have helped me become the cheerleader I'm growing into, and I am so excited for the future!!










Oma Grace Wood





