







































My name is Kailey Frank and I am 18 years old.


settle. Last month, I lost the state championship but never to be disheartened, though I am disappointed but proud to be on such a big stage. I made some



On my time off I enjoy spending time with my family and friends in the ocean on our boat. My batteries recharge when I am one with nature.




