



My biggest challenge today is to find a skateboard my size, lol, I'm very small.



I have many dreams: to go down a handrail and drop off a halfpipe.


My goal is to be a professional skateboarder and have a lot of fun with my little friends.

Just this week I become the brand Ambassador for Hominoid skateboards an Australian owned company. I was so excited to become part of their team.


I just want to keep growing and enjoying skateboarding, my favourite trick at the moment is airing out and the slash grind. I get inspired by







Can't wait to try out the new park!


Now we have to travel to Antwerp in Belgium if the weather is bad, but that's ok, since the SBA park is also a really nice park.
